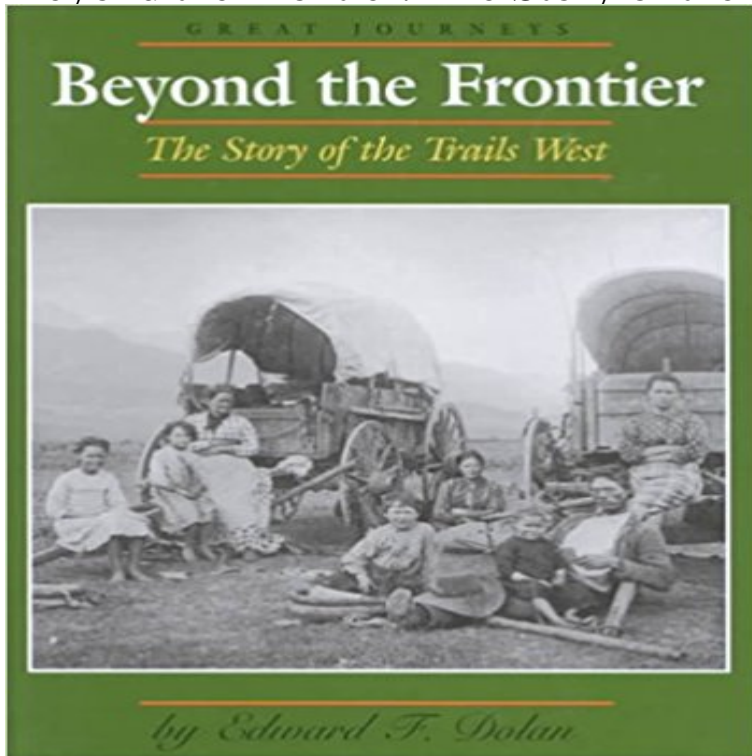


## Beyond the Frontier: The Story of the Trails West (Great Journeys)
