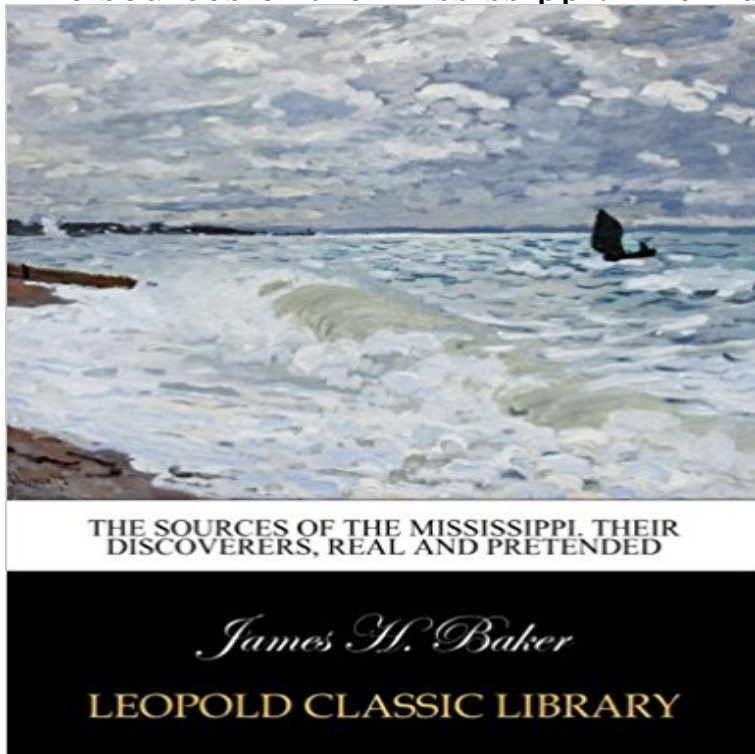


The sources of the Mississippi. Their discoverers, real and pretended
